

Respect Rules for Students

All students will be expected to adhere to the following rules, and any/all rules set by the individual teachers and those rules in the Student Parent Handbook:

- **Students will line up in the appropriate outdoor area, and wait quietly in line for the teacher.**
- **While in line, students will not engage in horseplay, loud talking, playing, or bouncing balls. NEVER be unkind to another student.**
- **Once the teacher has picked up the class, each student will silently walk in line, following the teacher's directives.**
- **Students will walk through interior hallways, single file, in silence.**
- **Each student will politely greet the teacher at the door.**
- **Upon entering the classroom, students will immediately take their seats, and wait for the teacher to give directions, or follow established classroom procedures as set by the teacher.**
- **During lessons, students will address teachers and other students respectfully.**
- **Students will raise their hands if they wish to speak, and will wait to be called upon.**
- **If a guest or pastor enters the room, students will stand and offer an appropriate greeting.**
- **Neither the restrooms nor the drinking fountains will be used during class time. (The restrooms and drinking fountains are to be used during recess and lunch only. Students will not loiter, and will clean up after themselves, in these areas.)**
- **Students will not leave their seats unless given permission by the teacher.**
- **When students are dismissed from the classroom, they will leave in a quiet and orderly fashion.**
