Families with lemon trees or access to someone who does please remember us – and send in what you can spare for fish fry. Please deliver to the parish hall or the school office on Thursdays.

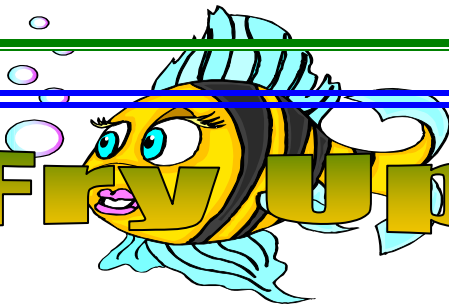
### **MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS**

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## FISH FRY DESSERT FLYER 2012

### Dessert Requirements

Desserts are very important to the fish fry menu. In order to ensure its continued success, we remind you of the following:

- Each dessert should be clearly marked with child's first and last name and grade.
- Each dessert should serve at least 8-10 people.
- Approximate cost of dessert is \$10 (unless homemade).
- Each child must provide desserts for two evenings as indicated below. If families have children in multiple grades assigned to the same night, a dessert is required for each child.
- A missed dessert will be billed at \$30. No make-ups will be allowed since this creates a shortage on the day the dessert was required.

\* Since there will be no school on Friday, March 23, you have the option of delivering your desserts to the hall on Thursday immediately following school dismissal or Friday morning after 9:30 a.m.. Again, please remember to check off your child's name on the class list.

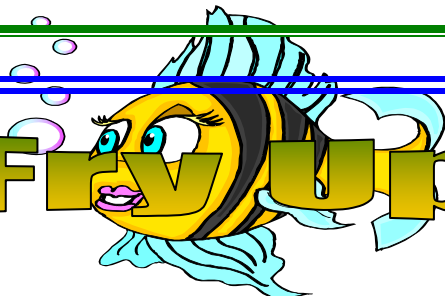
### Dessert Suggestions

Variety makes our dessert table fun and interesting. Our best-sellers from last year included: lemon bars, all homemade cookies, fancy cupcakes, pudding/marshmallow cups and brownies. Anything homemade sells quickly. The most requested pies included: lemon meringue, banana cream, cherry, coconut cream and sugar-free pies. On the other hand, angel food cake, prepackaged Danish, pan dulce and pre-packed cookies did not sell at all.

### Dessert Drop Off

There are two options for dessert drop off. The first option is to drop off dessert through the car line (south of the parish center). A parent will be there to receive your dessert and check off your child's name from the class list. This is the preferred option since all the desserts are accounted for and organized early in the day. The second option is to deliver desserts directly to the hall prior to 3:00 p.m. Please note, there will be no volunteers at the hall throughout the day, therefore parents are responsible for ensuring they have checked off their child's name on the assigned class list to receive credit. If a child's name is not checked off, it is assumed a dessert was missed. Your assistance with this is great appreciated.

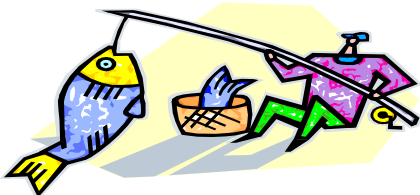
