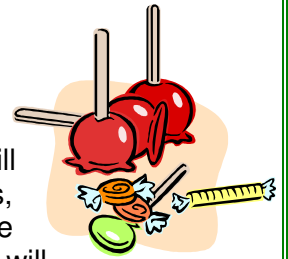

Report Cards will be passed out at the Conference.

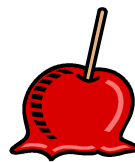
**Saint Bruno Families,**

## BINGO NEWS!!

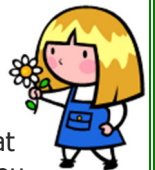

## St. Bruno's Daisy Scout Troop

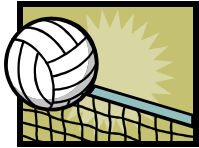
